

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Mobile District Celebrates Earth Day 2005



The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Mobile District's Black Warrior and Tombigbee River Lakes Demopolis Site office located in west central Alabama participated with Alabama Power's Renew our Rivers in National Earth Day activities during the week of April 5 - 9, 2005.

Combined efforts led to impressive numbers -- 368 volunteers spent 1,999 hours collecting more than 78,900 pounds of debris (39.45 tons) of trash from 12 corps-designated areas on Demopolis Lake.
