

## Picatinny Arsenal, New Jersey Celebrating Army Earth Day 2006

Picatinny Arsenal celebrated Army Earth Day on Thursday April 20, 2006. The day began with a nature walk sponsored by the Chugach Industries Environmental Office, and included a trail at the northern end of Lake Denmark. The hazardous materials program, HAZMART, was open during the day for the Picatinny residents to turn-in household waste.
