

CERT SERVICES The services CERT provides evolved in tandem with the development of Tribal capabilities and with the issues that confront Tribal goals. In the early years, CERT provided technical support for energy, geophysical and economic analysis. Since Tribes were denied an active role in determining the scale and scope of energy development under old federal Indian leases, Tribes were anxious to find out the true value of their production and their reserves. CERT supported Tribal negotiation teams with new valuation methodologies for determining value of Indian rights-of-way, joint ventures, taxable capacities of Tribal production and for royalties as well as with negotiation strategies. CERT assisted Tribes in economic diversification with market studies, business planning, and other enterprise development services. And because energy and economic development impact the natural environment, the Tribes built in CERT the technical capability for environmental protection. Through Tribal commitment to developing local capabilities through organizational and human development, these functions and the expertise to carry-out these functions now reside within the energy resource Tribes at the local level.

As these basic capacities were transferred to the Tribes, CERT, under the direction of the Tribal leadership, moved its attention to the changing North American energy markets; first the restructuring of the natural gas industry and now the introduction of competition in the electrical power markets. And because Tribal populations and economies are expanding at a rate much faster than that of other rural communities, CERT is now focusing on the internal domestic energy needs of Indian Tribes.
