Site Narrative

The one-acre Danzig Rifle Range is located near Ashley, McIntosh County, North Dakota. The range was established in the 1980s and was used for small arms training until at least 1992. The exact years of use are unknown. The range consisted of a single earthen target berm and no side berms. Fire was directed north to south. The Site Inspection (SI) field work was conducted in 2011. Lead contaminated soils were discovered. The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) residential screening criterion for soil is 400 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) for total lead. Two soil samples exceeded the standard with results of 1,400 mg/kg and 20,000 mg/kg. Two additional samples were also above the North Dakota background concentration of 31 mg/kg. The SI recommends additional investigation for munitions constituents (MC) and no further action (NFA) for munitions debris (MD) or munitions and explosives of concern (MEC).

Defense Environmental Restoration Program (DERP) funding was used to complete work through the SI phase at this site. Non-DoD Owned, Non-Operational Defense Sites (NDNODS) moving forward with the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) phase are reprogrammed into Compliance-related Cleanup (CC).

Cleanup/Exit Strategy An RI/FS will be completed at this site. Once the RI/FS is completed it is assumed a soil excavation will be required.

Site Narrative

A Preliminary Assessment (PA) was completed at Fargo Army Aviation Support Facility (AASF) #2 to assess potential per- and poly-fluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) release areas and exposure pathways to receptors. One Area of Interest (AOI) related to potential PFAS releases was identified at the Fargo AASF #2 during the PA. Interviews and records (covering 1993 to present) indicate that current or former Army National Guard activities may have resulted in potential PFAS releases at the one AOI identified during the PA. Based on the Conceptual Site Model developed for the AOI, there is potential for receptors to be exposed to PFAS contamination in soil, and groundwater at this AOI.

A Site Inspection (SI) is underway at the site. The draft final SI report was issued in September 2023, which concluded that no further actions are required.

Cleanup/Exit Strategy The site will be closed after the final SI report has been issued. No further actions are required.

Site Narrative

A Preliminary Assessment (PA) was completed at Bismarck Army Aviation Support Facility (AASF) to assess potential per- and poly-fluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) release areas and exposure pathways to receptors. One Area of Interest (AOI) related to potential PFAS releases was identified at the Bismarck AASF during the PA at the Main Hangar. Interviews with North Dakota Army National Guard personnel (whose first-hand knowledge of the facility span 1995 to present) and records indicate that activities may have resulted in potential PFAS releases at AOI 1 identified during the PA.

A Site Inspection (SI) was conducted and the final SI report was issued in September 2023. The SI reports Perfluorooctanoic Acid (PFOA), Perfluorooctane Sulfonic Acid (PFOS) and perfluorobutanesulfonic acid (PFBS) in groundwater at concentrations above screening levels in samples collected from AOI 1. Further investigation in a remedial investigation (RI) is recommended.

During the SI, it was discovered that TriMax30[™] fire extinguishers had occasionally been stored at the Fueling Area and the Fuel Truck Containment Structure since at least 2022. Based on this information, the Fueling Area and Fuel Truck Containment Structure will also be investigation as part of the RI.

The subject site was tracked as 38A15.1001 under the Compliance-related Cleanup (CC) program. In June 2022, this site was determined to be eligible for the Defense Environmental Restoration Program (DERP). The RI was awarded at the end of FY22 and will be conducted under DERP.

Cleanup/Exit Strategy The RI is funded and underway. Feasibility Study (FS) costs will require future funding. Further actions cannot be determined until after the RI/FS is complete.
