The office can serve as transfer hubs for bed bugs to catch a ride into your home. Vigilance by all employees is key!



- 1. Reduce clutter. Clutter serves as an ideal habitat for bed bugs.
- 2. Pay close attention to the seams of furniture and upholstery for telltale brownish spots.
- 3. Keep your belongings stowed separately from those of other people or consider storing your belongings in a plastic bin.
- 4. Bed bugs are mobile and able to move in buildings on your bags, purses or other items you carry in and out of your office.

SOMETHING TO REMEMBER:

- Bed bugs do not carry diseases.
- Bed bugs do not move in a building without human help.
- Bed bugs do not live in your clothes or on your body.
