* WEAR RUG SPRAY * WEAR LIGHT COLORED CLOTHES * WEAR LONG SLEEVED SHIRTS AND PANTS * * TUCK PANTS INTO SOCK 30 BOOTS * STAY ON TRAILS *

REMOVE CAREFULLY - DON'T LOSE THEIR HEAD



STEP 1 GRAB THE TICK CLOSE TO YOUR SKIN WITH THE TWEEZERS OR A TISSUE AND PULL STRAIGHT OUT. MAKE SURE YOU GET THE HEAD.

STEP = 2 PUT THE TICK IN A BAGGIE, JUST IN CASE.

STEP = 3 WASH WHERE THE TICK BIT YOU.

STEP = 4 WASH YOUR HANDS.

STEP 5 IF YOU GET SICK AFTER A TICK BITE, YOU SHOULD GO TO THE DOCTOR, AND TAKE THE TICK WITH YOU.
