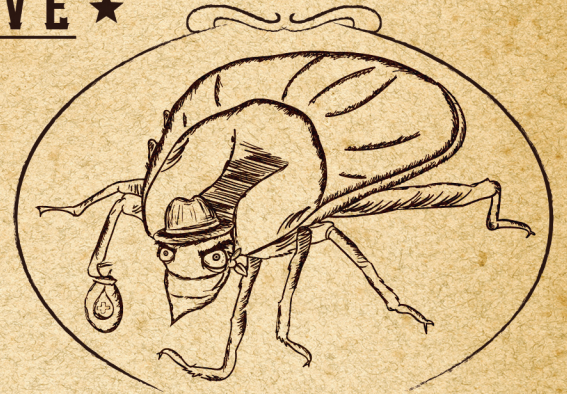

FIGHT THE BITE



★ WEAR BUG SPRAY ★ WEAR LIGHT COLORED CLOTHES ★ WEAR LONG SLEEVED SHIRTS AND PANTS ★
★ TUCK PANTS INTO SOCK AND BOOTS ★ STAY ON TRAILS ★

REMOVE CAREFULLY - DON'T LOSE THEIR HEAD

- STEP 1 GRAB THE TICK CLOSE TO YOUR SKIN WITH THE TWEEZERS OR A TISSUE AND PULL STRAIGHT OUT. MAKE SURE YOU GET THE HEAD.
- STEP 2 PUT THE TICK IN A BAGGIE, JUST IN CASE.
- STEP 3 WASH WHERE THE TICK BIT YOU.
- STEP 4 WASH YOUR HANDS.
- STEP 5 IF YOU GET SICK AFTER A TICK BITE, YOU SHOULD GO TO THE DOCTOR, AND TAKE THE TICK WITH YOU.
