The Army is planning to hold its next Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting as a virtual meeting on September 24 at 6 p.m. This RAB is being conducted virtually to maintain social distancing as required by Wisconsin's Stay at Home order and protect the health of the community during the COVID-19 response.

We need your input by September 11, 2020 on the attached USGS presentation.

At the July 30th RAB meeting, some members of the RAB and members of the community had questions about the mercury information provided by USGS previously. We have asked the USGS to re-present their information and respond to questions from the community at a meeting on September 24, 2020 at 6 p.m. via MS Teams. Please note, this is not part of the TAPP, which contracted the USGS to provide support for the RAB's review and comment submittal about the Groundwater RI/FS.

At this time, the only topic on the agenda of the September 24 meeting is Mercury. We will hold a regular RAB meeting in the October/November timeframe to discuss other topics of concern.
