Subject: July 25 Meeting - Badger Army Ammunition Plant

Dear Neighbors,

The Army is proposing a meeting on July 25 from 6 p.m. – 9 p.m. in the gallery at the Sauk Prairie School District's River Arts Center, 105 Ninth Street, Prairie du Sac, Wisconsin 53578.

Currently, we plan to share the results of the latest groundwater sampling and what we are going to do next. The U.S. Geological Survey team will provide a presentation on how they are evaluating the Army's current groundwater monitoring plan for the former Badger Army Ammunition Plant. We will provide you the latest Community Involvement Plan for your review and feedback. We can discuss any recommended changes at a future meeting. We want to leave sufficient time for your questions and concerns on all topics.

RAB members will receive draft minutes from the 16 May 2018 meeting within two weeks of the 25 July 2018 meeting.

We are proposing another meeting in September where we plan to provide information on the supplemental Remedial Investigation, including the Human Health Risk Assessment and the Feasibility Study, which we expect to have released to Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources by that time. If there is time, we will provide a status update on the groundwater monitoring and distribute the final Community Involvement Plan.

We are hoping to be able to meet with the community about every six weeks through the end of the year, but that will depend on defense budget approvals. We will contact you in advance for additional topics to discuss, but we will have to work together to determine the priorities and timing for providing different information and the best method to get you the information you need. In future meetings, we will discuss the Gruber's Grove Bay sampling results, diffuser structure and pipeline to Lake Wisconsin (suggested by a RAB member), sludge beds concern (suggested by a RAB member), regulatory authorities (topic suggested by RAB member), Gruber's Grove Bay way ahead and our plan to address the feedback received at the May meeting.
