The Army is planning to hold its next Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting as a virtual meeting on April 29th at 6 p.m. The public is invited to attend. This RAB is being conducted virtually to maintain social distancing in order to protect the health of the community during the COVID-19 response.

The purpose of the meeting is to introduce the Army's new story map, also known as a geonarrative, which has been designed with input from the community to better communicate water quality data and ultimately remediation activities. The agenda will include an update on the groundwater modeling effort, an update on the initial work plan for the Site Inspection at Settling Pond 2 and a discussion from the WDNR regarding PFAS. The Army will also provide updates on ongoing cleanup efforts at the former Badger Army Ammunition Plant.
