Twitter is a social media network, dedicated to creating a forum for its users to share and learn about up-to-the-minute news and information.

The U.S. Army Environmental Command (USAEC) uses Twitter to stay connected to the public and other organizations, or “followers”, by providing them with the latest programmatic news from around the globe.

HOW CAN I FOLLOW USAEC ON TWITTER?

Anyone can sign up for a Twitter account, simply by visiting www.twitter.com. Once an account is established, search for @USAEC, the Command’s Twitter name, and select “Follow” –

you will now have access to immediate USAEC news updates whenever you log on to your Twitter account from a computer or cell phone.
